Highlands Ranch Man Sentenced to Jail for Assaulting Mother of his Child While She Held Infant

Castle Rock, CO –A Douglas County judge has sentenced 25-year-old Keyahn Golgoon of Highlands Ranch to sixty days in the county jail and five years of supervised probation after a violent assault on the mother of his child while she was holding their eleven-month-old baby.

In November of 2025 a jury convicted Golgoon of multiple charges, stemming from the August 2024 attack, at the victim’s home in Highlands Ranch.

According to testimony, the victim confronted Golgoon about household chores. He followed her into a locked bathroom, forced his way inside, and grabbed her by the throat with both hands, applying pressure. The victim experienced blurred vision and dizziness as Golgoon threw her into the sink, and then against the bathroom door, all while she was holding their infant child.

The jury found Golgoon guilty of second-degree assault, third-degree assault, and child abuse. The jury also determined the crimes constituted acts of domestic violence.

Deputy District Attorney David Bosner, who prosecuted the case, had asked for 150 days in jail, but said the sentence still ensures accountability. “Although nothing can undo her suffering, our hope is this sentence brings the victim a measure of justice and peace,” said Bosner.

Douglas County Sheriff Darren Weekly praised the collaborative work of law enforcement and prosecutors that led to the conviction. “Domestic violence has no place in Douglas County, and our office will always pursue these cases to the fullest extent of the law.”
